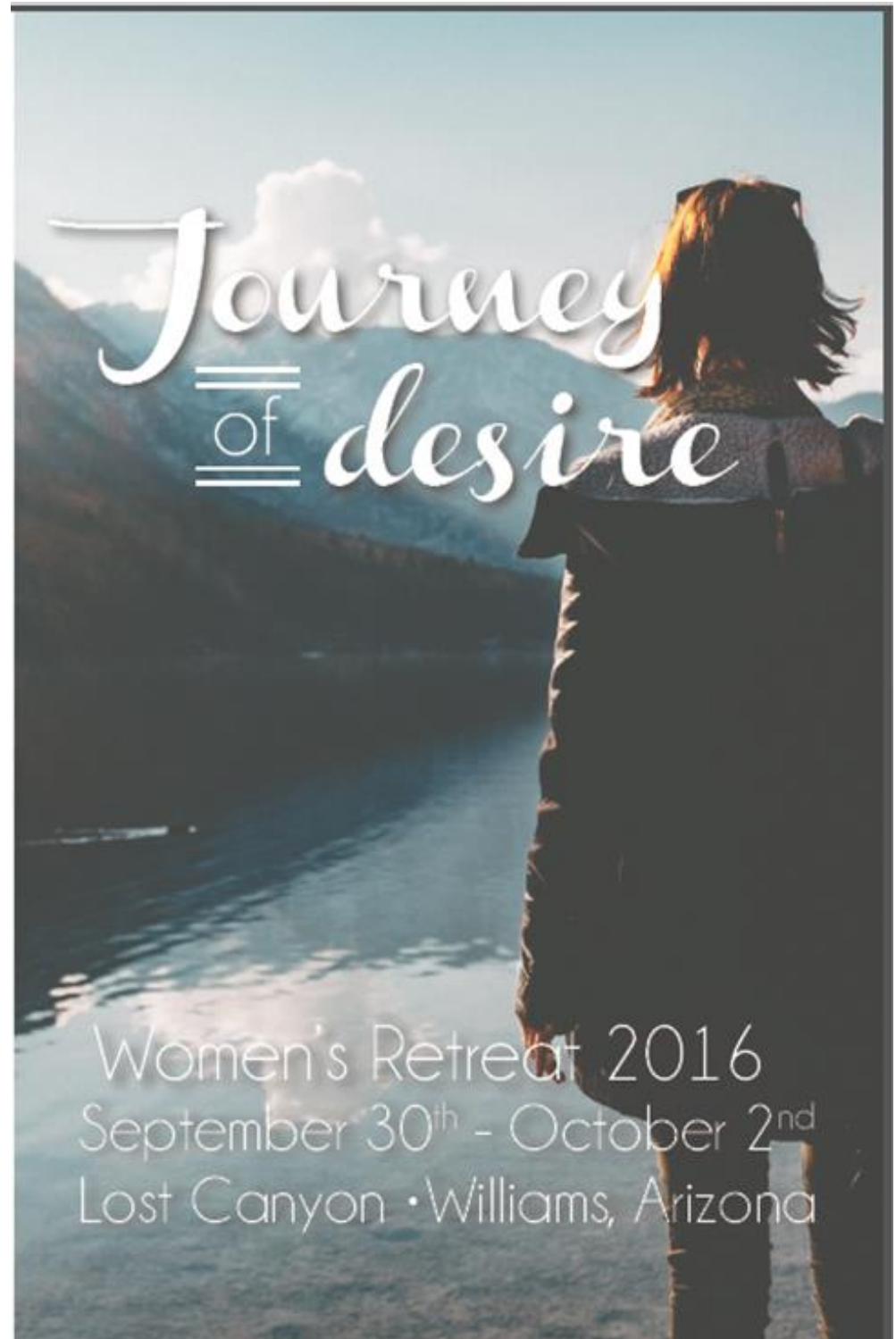
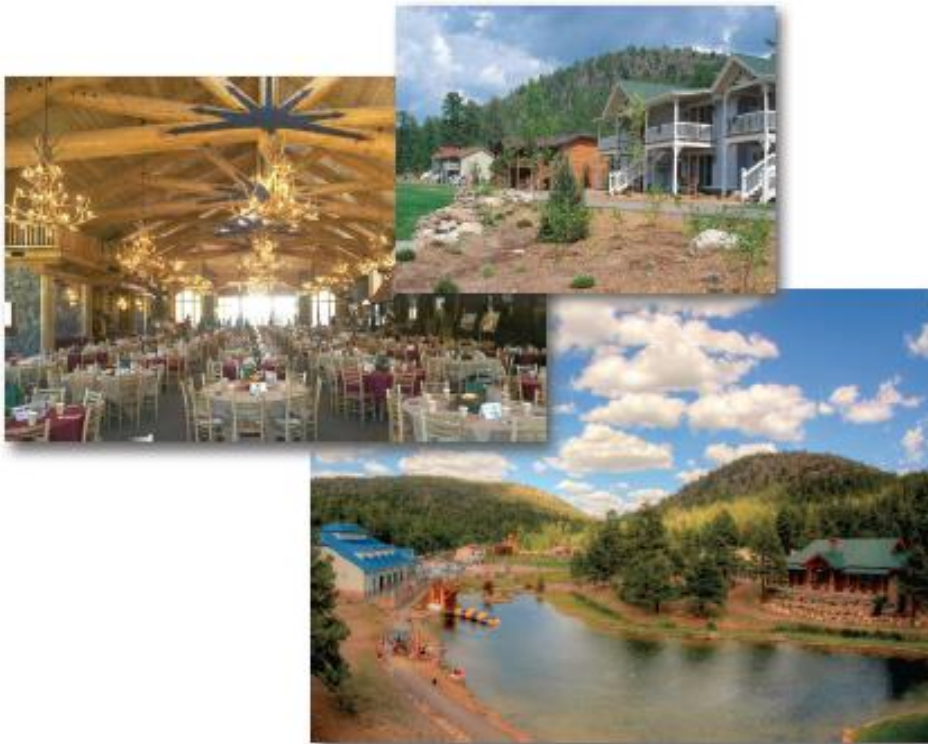


More about Lost Canyon
